

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Sykesville Sewage & Water Authority was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Fike with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those answering to roll call were Fike, Frantz, Matusky, Reiter and Sedor. Visitors were Rose Klaiber of the Punxsutawney Spirit and Travis Long of Gwin, Dobson and Foreman.

A Motion to Approve the Minutes of the July 21, 2014 Meeting was made by Reiter and seconded by Frantz. Motion carried unanimously.

Matusky reported the usage numbers at the sewage treatment plant are up to 24 % with Sandy, Winslow and Troutville using 8% of the plant.

Travis Long discussed the water rates and plans on bringing in PennVest to talk to the authority regarding how much rates would need to be increased for the new waterline.

Regarding Sandy Township, Long suggested Sykesville set an area of service so they cannot just come in and take over our water customers. This would need to be discussed with our solicitor in order to protect the interest of the borough.

The Authority feels an 8" line is more than adequate for as the new replacement line. The line from the county to the borough is an 8" line.

With the new line, the chlorine booster will be located at the county line.

Being that ductile iron is so expensive, cvc pipe 900, with a tracer wire for tracing will be used.

SDR plastic line will be used to connect residents which will not freeze or break.

Sedor asked how the payment box was working out. He was told it is fine.

A Motion to Adjourn was made by Reiter and seconded by Sedor. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned.
