

ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND THE USE OF CONTAINERS, LIMITING THE TYPE AND CHARACTER OF CONTAINERS AND REGULATING THE HANDLING AND PLACING OF GARBAGE FOR COLLECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Sykesville in regular session assembled that the collection of garbage in the Borough of Sykesville be and the same shall be regulated under the following rules and regulations:

SECTION 1. Garbage, under this Ordinance, is hereby defined as household waste and shall not include any debris or waste accumulating on the property outside of the dwelling or house.

SECTION 2. All garbage to be collected by the Borough shall be wrapped in paper and placed in metal containers with lids thereon, which shall not exceed 30 gallons capacity. Such containers shall be placed at the edge of the roadway, not before 7:00 p. m. the day before collection and not later than 8:00 a. m. o'clock on the day on which garbage is to be collected. Said containers shall contain no other waste or material other than household waste as defined in the definition of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ashes shall be collected on the condition that said ashes shall be placed in wooden or metal containers holding not more than one bushel of ashes. No ashes will be collected in any event which have been placed in cardboard or other containers subject to weakening and deterioration by water.

SECTION 4. No person shall place any garbage or ashes on the streets, lots, or sidewalks, streams or alleys, unless the same shall be in containers as herein defined and any such placing of garbage or ashes or other waste and debris shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Any person found guilty of violating any of the terms of this Ordinance shall upon summary conviction before the Burgess or Justice of the Peace be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$2.00 (Two dollars) nor more than \$10.00 (Ten dollars) or undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding 5 days together with all of the costs of prosecution.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
